Air America Flight Center is based in Daytona Beach, Florida, at the Daytona Beach International Airport (KDAB). While starting as a flight training center, Air America has transitioned a substantial part of the fleet into aerial imaging and photogrammetric services. Air America currently boasts a fleet of 30+ aircraft and 40+ pilots, divided as needed between the flight training facility and imaging contracts. Although Air America is based in the Southeastern United States, company aircraft are utilized in aerial imaging services throughout North America and the Caribbean. Air America's fleet is in service seven days a week, year-round, in contracts ranging from small, single-site missions to large-scale, recurring annual projects. Air America has operated imaging aircraft for more than three years in all 48 contiguous states, as well as parts of Canada, Mexico, and Puerto Rico.

While Air America Flight Center does not own photogrammetric equipment, it provides a platform upon which imaging companies can employ their own technology with the quality aircraft and skilled pilots of Air America. Listed below are the makes and models of aircraft that Air America currently operates:

With the appropriate engineering documentation (Standard Type Certificate or FAA Form-337), Air America's in-house maintenance facility is capable of retrofitting any aircraft to fit the design specifications of the equipment to be used.
